

### **EXCLUSIVE LAKE EYRE – ONE DAY TOUR**

#### **Itinerary:**

7.30am Be ready and waiting with hand luggage in reception of any hotel in Adelaide's CBD for private transfers to Adelaide Airport.

On arrival at the airport, meet your Chinta Tours pilot/guide, and prepare for immediate departure to Lake Eyre on a private charter flight.

Aircraft: The fleet includes twin engine Piper Chieftans, Aerocommanders, or single engine Cessnas. Aircraft to be selected at the time of booking.

Features: Uninterrupted views of passing scenery.  
Average true air speed – up to 160 knots/320 kilometres per hour.  
Capacity – up to eight passengers.  
Each passenger will be seated in a window seat.  
As space is limited, we prefer luggage to be packed in soft-sided bags that are a maximum of 70cms x 40cms x 25cms (25 inches x 15 inches x 10 inches) in size.  
Luggage limits apply for all flights

Aircraft can choose from single engine aircraft or twin engine aircraft – type of aircraft must be confirmed at the time of booking.
